AN ACT

Relating to state regulation of fireworks; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

AN ACT

Relating to state regulation of fireworks; and providing for an effective date.

* Section 1. AS 18.72.020(a)(1) is amended to read:

(1) the person has submitted to the state fire marshal a policy, or a certified true copy of a policy, of public liability and products liability insurance, including both accident and occurrence coverage, provided by the wholesale company selling [TO THE] fireworks to the person [RETAILER], in the amount of at least \$200,000 [\$300,000] for bodily injury or death and at least \$50,000 [\$100,000] property damage [, UPON WHICH POLICY THE STATE AND ALL GOVERNMENTAL SUBDIVISIONS OF THE STATE] and the person is [PERMIT HOLDER SHALL BE] named as an insured party upon the policy [ADDITIONAL INSURED] and the policy is [WHICH SHALL BE] continuously in force while the person [PERMIT HOLDER] is engaged in the retail sale of fireworks, and

* Sec. 2. AS 18.72.030(a) is amended to read:

(a) A person who desires to sell fireworks at wholesale in the state shall first make verified application for a license to the state fire marshal on forms provided by him. The application shall be accompanied by an annual license fee of \$50 [\$500].

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-070(c).
