AN ACT

Relating to the naming of highways, vessels, and marine facilities constructed or acquired by the state; and providing for an effective date.

* Section 1. AS 19.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 19.05.150. NAMING OF A HIGHWAY. (a) A highway constructed by the department under AS 19.05 - 19.40 may be given a name only by law.

(b) This section does not apply to

(1) a road constructed by a municipality under a grant authorized by AS 19.05 - 19.40;

(2) local service roads and trails.

* Sec. 2. AS 19.65 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 19.65.020. NAMING OF VESSEL OR FACILITY. (a) A vessel or facility of the Alaska marine highway system constructed or acquired by the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities under AS 19.60 - 19.65 may be given a name only by law.

(b) A maritime vessel shall bear the name of an Alaska glacier.

(c) A vessel used principally on the inland waterways of the state shall bear the name of an historical vessel which used the rivers of the state.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-070(c).
