## AN ACT

Extending certain insurance coverage to judges and justices receiving benefits under the judicial retirement system and to elected officials receiving benefits under the elected public officers retirement system; and providing for an effective date.

AN ACT

\* Section 1. AS 39.30.090(15) is amended to read:

(15) A person receiving benefits under AS 14.25, AS 22.25, [OR] AS 39.35, or former AS 39.37 may obtain auditory, visual, and dental insurance for himself under this section. The level of coverage for persons over 65 shall be the same as that available before reaching age 65 except that the benefits payable shall be supplemental to those afforded under the federal old age, survivors, and disability insurance program, if any. A person electing to have insurance under this paragraph shall pay the cost of the insurance. The commissioner of administration shall adopt regulations implementing this paragraph.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-070(c).
