AN ACT

Relating to donations of personal leave; and
providing for an effective date.

* Section 1. AS 39.20.245 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(b) An employee of the legislature or of a legislative agency with the approval of the person authorizing the employment may donate accrued personal leave to another employee of the legislature or of a legislative agency only for use as leave for medical reasons. The official responsible for legislative employee accounts shall debit the donor's personal leave account and credit the donee's personal leave account, for medical reasons only, by converting the donated leave into cash value at the donor's rate of pay and reconverting the cash value to hours of leave at the donee's rate of pay. Leave donated under this subsection is not leave taken by the donor for purposes of AS 39.20.-225(c).

* Sec. 2. This Act is retroactive to January 1, 1981.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-070(c).
