* Section 1. AS 28.15.241(c) is amended to read:

(c) One [FROM JANUARY 1, 1975, ONE] point shall accumulate to the driver's benefit for each 12 consecutive months [YEAR] of licensed, violation-free driving within the five-year period preceding the point calculation.
