Requesting the governor to grant a pardon to Daniel Boone Reed.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Daniel Boone Reed, having been convicted of arson in 1941 and having served eight years in federal jail, had his civil rights revoked; and

WHEREAS Daniel Boone Reed has been an exemplary, law-abiding citizen since his release from jail more than 30 years ago; and

WHEREAS Daniel Boone Reed, now in his seventies and a longtime resident of Kodiak Island, is a leader among its senior citizens and well respected throughout the community;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests the governor to grant Daniel Boone Reed a full pardon and restore his civil rights.
