Relating to the inauguration of Ronald Reagan and George Bush.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS Ronald Wilson Reagan and George Herbert Walker Bush captured 489 electoral votes, including Alaska's three electoral votes, in their victory in the November 1980 election for President and Vice President of the United States; and

WHEREAS Ronald Reagan, as former Governor of California, brings to the office of the President an understanding of and sympathy for the problems of Western States; and

WHEREAS Ronald Reagan and George Bush, both having visited this state, recognize Alaska's important role in the future of the United States and the world; and

WHEREAS Ronald Reagan and George Bush offer the prospect of better relations between the State of Alaska and the federal government;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Senate extends its official congratulations to President-elect Ronald Reagan and Vice President-elect George Bush; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the members representing the Alaska State Senate at the inauguration are requested to personally deliver this resolution to President Ronald Reagan and Vice President George Bush during Inaugural Week in Washington, D.C.
