Relating to the establishment of a Senate Special Committee on the Alaska Railroad.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:**

WHEREAS the federal government desires to relinquish ownership of the Alaska Railroad; and

WHEREAS state control of the Alaska Railroad is one of the possible alternatives under consideration; and

WHEREAS the Alaska delegation in Congress has emphasized that it is important for the state to designate a person or entity that has authority to enter into discussions with the federal government concerning the transfer of the Alaska Railroad; and

WHEREAS the Alaska delegation in Congress has also stated that time is of the essence in participating in negotiations for the transfer of the Alaska Railroad;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Senate that a Senate Special Committee on the Alaska Railroad is established to represent the Senate in any negotiations relating to the transfer of the Alaska Railroad from federal ownership; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee consists of three senators; the president of the senate shall appoint the members and designate a member to chair the committee; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee is authorized to meet during and between sessions of the legislature and is terminated on January 10, 1983.
