Requesting the Alaska Railroad to continue daily service to Talkeetna.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS the Alaska Railroad has for many years included Talkeetna as a daily stop during the summer months; and

WHEREAS Talkeetna is a tourist and recreation area which is enjoyed by both residents of the state and visitors from outside; and

WHEREAS many of the people who visit Talkeetna rely on rail service to reach the community; and

WHEREAS the Alaska Railroad proposes to discontinue daily service to Talkeetna; and

WHEREAS the discontinuance of daily service would have a serious impact on the entire business community in Talkeetna;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Senate respectfully requests the General Manager of the Alaska Railroad to continue daily service to Talkeetna.
