\* Section 1. AS 24.05.100 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(b) A special session may be held at any location in the state.

If a special session called under (a)(1) of this section is to be convened at a location other than at the capital, the governor shall designate the location in his proclamation. If a special session called under (a)(2) of this section is to be convened at a location other than at the capital, the presiding officers shall agree to and designate the location in the poll conducted of the members of both houses.
