AN ACT

Providing for free resident hunting and sport fishing licenses for disabled veterans; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 16.05.340(a)(4) is amended to read:

(4) Resident hunting and sport fishing license.....22

However, a person may receive a resident hunting and sport fishing license without charge if the person

(A) has been discharged from military service under honorable conditions;

(B) is eligible for a loan under AS 18.56.101; and

(C) is certified by the United States Veterans' Administration as having incurred a 50 percent or greater disability during military service.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 1983.
