AN ACT

Exempting restaurants, grocery stores, and established fish markets from the labor bond required of fish processors and primary fish buyers; and providing for an effective date.

\* Section 1. AS 16.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 16.10.293. EXEMPTIONS FROM BONDING REQUIREMENT. (a) Restaurants, grocery stores, and established fish markets are exempt from the bonding requirement of AS 16.10.290 - 16.10.295.

(b) For purposes of this section

(1) "established fish market" means a market maintained in a permanent structure exclusively for the sale of seafood to the public at retail;

(2) "grocery store" means a store maintained for the sale of food products exclusively to the public at retail;

(3) "restaurant" includes a place maintained for the sale and on-premise consumption of food, and a street vendor who sells food prepared for immediate consumption.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-070(c).
