\* Section 1. Section 29, ch. 82, SLA 1981, page 108, lines 3 - 16, is amended to read:

Sec. 29. The following appropriation items are for operating expenditures from the general fund or other funds as set out in the fiscal year 1982 budget summary by funding source to the state agencies named and for the purposes set out in the new legislation for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1981 and ending June 30, 1982; except that the appropriation made to the Citizens' Advisory Commission on Federal Management Areas at page 110, line 20, of this Act is for the period beginning July 1, 1981 and ending June 30, 1983. The appropriation items contain funding for legislation assumed to have passed during the First Session of the Twelfth Legislature and are to be considered part of the agency operating budget. Should a measure listed in this section either fail to pass, its substance fail to be incorporated in some other measure, or be vetoed by the governor, the appropriation for that measure shall lapse.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-070(c).
