AN ACT

Relating to the staff of the Citizens' Advisory Commission on Federal Areas in Alaska; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 41.37.070 is amended to read:

Sec. 41.37.070. STAFF OF THE COMMISSION. The commission may employ staff and contract for services relating to matters within its authority. Staff employed under this section are in the exempt service under AS 39.25.110, serve at the pleasure of the commission, and receive compensation fixed by the commission [RESPONSIBLE TO THE COMMISSION].

* Sec. 2. AS 39.25.110 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

(27) employees of the Citizens' Advisory Commission on Federal Areas in Alaska (AS 41.37.010).

* Sec. 3. AS 39.25.110(27) is repealed.

* Sec. 4. Sections 1 and 2 of this Act take effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.070(c).

* Sec. 5. Section 3 of this Act takes effect June 30, 1988.
