AN ACT

Making appropriations to the Office of the Governor and to the Legislative Affairs Agency to pay additional costs of salaries and benefits for fiscal year 1982; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

AN ACT

Making appropriations to the Office of the Governor and to the Legislative Affairs Agency to pay additional costs of salaries and benefits for fiscal year 1982; and providing for an effective date.

* Section 1. The sum of \$16,121,600 is appropriated to the Office of the Governor for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1982 for additional costs of salaries and benefits for the general government, supervisory, and confidential bargaining units, and for state employees and public and judicial officers not covered by collective bargaining, allocated as follows:

(1) The sum of \$8,076,100 is allocated for the general government unit contract from the following sources:

16 * Sec. 2. The sum of \$447,400 is appropriated from the general fund to
17 the Legislative Affairs Agency for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1982 for
18 additional salaries and benefits for legislators and for permanent employees
19 of the legislature.

20 * Sec. 3. The sums appropriated for additional costs of salaries and
21 benefits for the general government, supervisory and confidential bargaining
22 units, and for state employees, public and judicial officers, and legislators
23 and permanent employees of the legislature not covered by collective bargain-
24 ing for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1983, are included within the amounts
25 appropriated for personal services in CSHB 666 (Finance) (Twelfth Legisla-
26 ture), the general appropriations act. The amounts required to cover the
27 salary and benefits increases for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1983, are
28 made available through a statewide five percent reduction of authorized
29 full-time and part-time state positions.
