AN ACT

Relating to membership in electric and telephone cooperatives.

Relating to membership in electric and tele-
phone cooperatives.

* Section 1. AS 10.25.080 is amended to read:

Sec. 10.25.080. MEMBERS. Each incorporator of a cooperative shall be a member of the cooperative or of another cooperative that is a member of it. No [OTHER] person may become a member unless that person [HE] agrees to use electric energy, or telephone service, or other services furnished by the cooperative when they are made available through its facilities. Membership in a cooperative is not transferable, except as provided in the bylaws. The bylaws may prescribe additional qualifications and limitations on membership.
