AN ACT

Making supplemental appropriations to the Department of Public Safety for salaries and benefits; making appropriations to the Legislative Affairs Agency; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

AN ACT

Making supplemental appropriations to the Department of Public Safety for salaries and benefits; making appropriations to the Legislative Affairs Agency; and providing for an effective date.

* Section 1. The sum of \$920,300 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Public Safety for fiscal year 1982 for the additional costs of salaries and benefits for the public safety bargaining unit.

* Sec. 2. The sum of \$1,814,400 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Public Safety for fiscal year 1983 for the additional costs of salaries and benefits for the public safety bargaining unit.

* Sec. 3. The sum of \$1,150,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Legislative Affairs Agency for the operation of the Twelfth Legislature - Second Session from the 123rd day through the 145th legislative day.

* Sec. 4. The sum of \$139,781 is appropriated from the general fund to the legal services division, Legislative Affairs Agency for direct settlement costs for the case of Haley v. State, IJU-79-575 Civ.

* Sec. 5. The sum of \$31,744 is appropriated from the general fund to the Legislative Affairs Agency to finance the reimbursable services agreement entered into between the Legislative Council and the Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission in the case of Haley v. State, IJU-79-575 Civ.

* Sec. 6. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-10.070(c).
