Relating to the speed limits at Ninilchik from Mile 134.6 to Mile 137 of the Sterling Highway and from the Parks Highway to Mile 1.0 of the Petersville Road.

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities operates and maintains the transportation facilities of the state including state highways; and

WHEREAS the management of state highways includes the determination and posting of appropriate speed limits for traffic on those highways; and

WHEREAS the present speed limit at Ninilchik between Mile 134.6 and Mile 137 of the Sterling Highway is 45 miles per hour; and

WHEREAS the safety and general welfare of the people of Ninilchik and those traveling the Sterling Highway would be enhanced if the speed of traffic were reduced between Mile 134.6 and Mile 137 of the Sterling Highway; and

WHEREAS the present speed limit from the Parks Highway to Mile 1.0 of the Petersville Road is 40 miles per hour; and

WHEREAS the safety and general welfare of the people of Petersville Road would be enhanced if the speed of traffic were reduced from the Parks Highway to Mile 1.0 of the Petersville Road;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the commissioner of transportation and public facilities to take the necessary action to reduce the speed limit between Mile 134.6 and Mile 137 of the Sterling Highway from 45 miles per hour to 35 miles per hour and to reduce the speed limit from the Parks Highway

to Mile 1.0 of the Petersville Road from 40 miles per hour to 30 miles per hour.
