Establishing a Joint Committee on Salmon Quality Control and Marketing.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the salmon industry is a critical part of the economy of the state; and

WHEREAS a high quality salmon product is required in order to compete economically in the marketplace; and

WHEREAS proper methods of handling and processing salmon are essential to the health of consumers; and

WHEREAS problems in marketing Alaska salmon will have an adverse impact on the economy of the state;

BE IT RESOLVED that the president of the senate appoint four senators and the speaker of the house appoint four representatives to a Joint Committee on Salmon Quality Control and Marketing to work with members of the commercial salmon fishing, processing and marketing industries to improve quality control and marketing of Alaska salmon; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the existence of the Joint Committee on Salmon Quality Control and Marketing is terminated upon adjournment sine die of the Second Session of the Twelfth Legislature.
