AN ACT

Relating to racing events on public highways.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

AN ACT

Relating to racing events on public highways.

* Section 1. AS 05.90.001(a) is amended to read:

(a) To the extent that it is consistent with federal law and regulations, a [SNOW VEHICLES, AUTOMOBILES, AND MOTORCYCLES MAY BE OPERATED ON STATE HIGHWAYS FOR] special racing event [EVENTS] of limited duration that is [WHICH ARE] conducted according to (b) of this section may be held on a state highway.

* Sec. 2. AS 05.90.001(b) is repealed and reenacted to read:

(b) The Department of Public Safety, with the concurrence of the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, may grant, and for cause cancel, permission to conduct a special racing event as provided in this section upon terms and conditions and at times and places the department may determine. If an applicant's permission is refused or canceled, the applicant may request the Department of Public Safety for a hearing. The hearing shall be conducted under the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62).
