AN ACT

Relating to a brown and grizzly bear tag fee for a resident; and providing for an effective date.

* Section 1. AS 16.05.340(a)(18)(A) is amended to read:

(A) Bear, brown or grizzly, each.....25

The Board of Game may, by regulation effective for not more than one year, eliminate the resident brown or grizzly bear tag and fee for all or a portion of a game management unit.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-10.070(c).
