AN ACT

Making special appropriations for payment as grants for the Wrangell Totem Poles and Chief Shakes Island Preservation and Restoration Project, and for the Sealaska Heritage Foundation Language and Cultural Studies Program; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

AN ACT

Making special appropriations for payment as grants for the Wrangell Totem Poles and Chief Shakes Island Preservation and Restoration Project, and for the Sealaska Heritage Foundation Language and Cultural Studies Program; and providing for an effective date.

* Section 1. The sum of \$178,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Natural Resources for payment as a grant to the Sealaska Heritage Foundation for the Wrangell Totem Poles and Chief Shakes Island Preservation and Restoration Project.

* Sec. 2. The sum of ~~\$261,700~~^{250,000 *add.*} is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Natural Resources for payment as a grant to the Sealaska Heritage Foundation for the Language and Cultural Studies Program.

* Sec. 3. The appropriations made by this Act shall be disbursed in accordance with AS 37.05.316.

* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-10.070(c).
