BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 11.66.110(c) is amended to read:

(c) Except as provided in (d) of this section, promoting [PRO-
MOTING] prostitution in the first degree is a class B felony.

* Sec. 2. AS 11.66.110 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(d) A person convicted under (a)(2) of this section is guilty of
a class A felony.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-
10.070(c).
