Establishing a Senate Special Agriculture Committee.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS it is the policy of the legislature to promote a diversified and stable renewable resource economy through the investment of nonrenewable resource revenues; and

WHEREAS the development of agricultural production is an important facet of the renewable resource economy; and

WHEREAS the objective of the state is to develop economically viable, environmentally sound, and energy efficient agricultural production to diversify and stabilize the economy of the state;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Senate that a Senate Special Committee on Agriculture is established to examine and make recommendations to the Senate concerning the development of economically viable, environmentally sound, and energy efficient agricultural production to diversify and stabilize the economy of the state; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the president of the senate shall determine the number of senators to be members of the committee, and shall appoint the members and designate a member to chair the committee; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee is authorized to meet during and between sessions of the legislature and shall terminate January 20, 1985.
