AN ACT

Relating to the crime of terroristic threatening; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 11.56.810 is amended to read:

Sec. 11.56.810. TERRORISTIC THREATENING. (a) A person commits
the crime of terroristic threatening if the person

(1) knowingly makes a false report that a circumstance
dangerous to human life exists or is about to exist and

(A) [(1)] places a person in fear of physical injury
to any person;

(B) [(2)] causes evacuation of a building; or

(C) [(3)] causes serious public inconvenience; or

(2) with intent to place another person in fear of death or
serious physical injury to the person or the person's immediate
family, makes repeated threats to cause death or serious physical
injury to another person.

(b) Terroristic threatening is a class C felony.
