\* Section 1. AS 44.12 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 44.12.055. BOB BARTLETT DAY. Bob Bartlett Day is established on April 20 of each year to honor E.L. "Bob" Bartlett, the "architect of Alaska statehood," for a lifetime of public service to Alaska and the nation. Bob Bartlett Day may be observed by suitable observances and exercises by civic groups and the public.
