AN ACT

Establishing "Ernest Gruening Day" on February 6 of each year.

* Section 1. AS 44.12 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 44.12.050. ERNEST GRUENING DAY. Ernest Gruening Day is established on February 6 of each year to honor Ernest Gruening, doctor, editor, and statesman, for a lifetime of service to the territory and state of Alaska and the nation. Ernest Gruening Day may be observed by suitable observances and exercises by civic groups and the public.
