AN ACT

Relating to physicians' staff privileges in hospitals.

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\* Section 1. AS 18.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 18.20.076. REPORTS OF SUSPENDED OR REVOKED STAFF PRIVILEGES. (a) Within seven days after suspending or revoking the staff privileges of a physician, a hospital shall notify the State Medical Board in writing of the name of the physician and the circumstances involved in the suspension or revocation.

(b) The notice under (a) of this section is subject to the confidentiality provisions of AS 18.20.090 and AS 18.23.030.
