**AN ACT**

Relating to lobbying; and providing for an effective date.

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**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

Relating to lobbying; and providing for an effective date.

\* Section 1. AS 24.45.121(a) is amended to read:

(a) A [NO] lobbyist may not

(1) engage in any activity as a lobbyist before registering under AS 24.45.041;

(2) do anything with the intent of placing a public official under personal obligation to the lobbyist [HIM] or to the lobbyist's [HIS] employer;

(3) intentionally deceive or attempt to deceive any public official with regard to any material fact pertinent to pending or proposed legislative or administrative action;

(4) cause or influence the introduction of a legislative measure for the purpose of thereafter being employed to secure its defeat;

(5) cause a communication to be sent to a public official in the name of any fictitious person or in the name of any real person, except with the consent of that person;

(6) accept or agree to accept any payment in any way contingent upon the defeat, enactment or outcome of any proposed legislative or administrative action;

(7) serve as a member of a state board, or commission, if the lobbyist's employer may receive direct economic benefit from a

3                   Sec. 37.05.321. RESTRICTION ON USE. A grant or earnings from a  
4                   grant made under AS 37.05.315 - 37.05.317 may not be used for the  
5                   purpose of influencing legislative action. In this section "influencing  
6                   legislative action" means promoting, advocating, supporting,  
7                   modifying, opposing, or delaying or seeking to do the same with re-  
8                   spect to any legislative action but does not include the provision or  
9                   use of information, statistics, studies, or analyses in written or  
10                   oral form or format. A grant or earnings from a grant made under  
11                   AS 37.05.315 - 37.05.317 may not be used for purposes of travel in  
12                   connection with influencing legislative action unless pursuant to a  
13                   specific request from a legislator or legislative committee.
