AN ACT

* Section 1. AS 47.90.070(2) is amended to read:

(2) "displaced homemaker" means a person who

(A) has worked as a homemaker providing unsalaried services for the family for a period of at least three [SEVEN] years;

(B) faces a significant reduction in family income or support through divorce, death, separation, desertion, or disability; and

(C) has encountered difficulty in finding employment.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-10.070(c).
