\* Section 1. AS 39.50.200(a)(1) is amended to read:

(1) "public official" means a judicial officer, a member of the legislature, the fiscal analyst of the legislative finance division, the legislative auditor of the legislative audit division, the executive director of the Legislative Affairs Agency and the directors of the divisions within the Legislative Affairs Agency, the governor, the lieutenant governor, a person hired or appointed as the head or deputy head of, or director of a division within, a department in the executive branch, an assistant to the governor, chairman or member of a state commission or board, and each appointed or elected municipal officer;
