AN ACT

Relating to the preparation of the executive budget; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Relating to the preparation of the executive budget; and
providing for an effective date.

* Section 1. AS 37.07.020(a) is amended to read:

(a) The governor shall prepare and submit to the legislature before the fourth legislative day a budget for the succeeding fiscal year which shall cover all estimated receipts, including all grants, loans, and money received from the federal government, and all proposed expenditures of the state government. The budget submitted by the governor shall be organized so that the proposed expenditures for each agency are presented separately. The budget shall be accompanied by a general appropriation bill to authorize the proposed expenditures, and a bill or bills covering recommendations in the budget for new or additional revenues. The proposed general appropriation bill shall become public information on December 15 of each year at which time the governor shall submit copies to the legislature and make copies available to the public.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-10.070(c).
