AN ACT

Relating to embalmer and funeral director trainees.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Relating to embalmer and funeral director trainees.

* Section 1. AS 08.42 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 08.42.085. QUALIFICATIONS FOR TRAINEES. (a) A person may apprentice as an embalmer trainee if the person

(1) is at least 18 years of age;

(2) applies on a form provided by the department; and

(3) furnishes evidence satisfactory to the department that an embalmer licensed in this state will supervise the training and that the training will take place in a funeral establishment that meets the requirements of AS 08.42.100.

(b) A person may apprentice as a funeral director trainee if the person

(1) is at least 18 years of age;

(2) applies on a form provided by the department; and

(3) furnishes evidence satisfactory to the department that a funeral director licensed in this state will supervise the training and that the training will take place in a funeral establishment that meets the requirements of AS 08.42.100.

(c) The department shall issue a permit valid for one year to an applicant who meets the requirements of this section. The department shall renew a permit for one year if the trainee applies for renewal on a form provided by the department and shows that the training

1 activity continues to satisfy the requirements of this section. The
2 department will charge a fee for processing applications and renewals
3 under this section which will be sufficient to cover administrative
4 costs.

5 (d) A person may apprentice as a funeral director trainee or as
6 an embalmer trainee for no more than two years.
