Relating to "Lower" Huffman Road upgrading in the Municipality of Anchorage.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Huffman Road is a major access road to Chugach State Park and to the foothill area of southern Anchorage serving many of the 4,049 persons residing within an area bounded by Seward Highway, O'Malley Road, De Armoun Road and Birch Road; and

WHEREAS the road is inadequate for the motor vehicles using it and the lack of shoulders makes it hazardous for pedestrians and school children walking along the road; and

WHEREAS Huffman Road between Seward Highway and Birch Road is in a deplorable condition, is narrow and in need of upgrading;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests the governor to direct the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to seek funds to upgrade and reconstruct Huffman Road between Seward Highway and Birch Road using available appropriation for that purpose.
