AN ACT

Relating to the transplanting of elk.

* Section 1. The Department of Fish and Game shall, during the next three years, transplant to Zarembo Island or other appropriate locations in Southeast Alaska, not fewer than 30 elk nor more than 150 elk. These elk may not be taken from Afognak Island. The department shall utilize the services of volunteers, organizations and groups to accomplish this transplanting whenever possible.
