AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 23.30.005(a) is amended to read:

(a) The Alaska Workers' Compensation Board consists [SHALL
CONSIST] of [NINE MEMBERS, INCLUDING] a southern panel of three mem-
bers sitting for the first judicial district, a northern panel of
three members sitting for the second and fourth judicial districts,
two southcentral panels [A SOUTH-CENTRAL PANEL] of three members each
sitting for the third judicial district, and one panel of three mem-
bers that may sit in any judicial district. Each panel must [SHALL]
include the commissioner of labor or the designated representative of
the commissioner, a representative of industry, and a representative
of labor. The latter two members of each panel shall be appointed by
the governor and [. ALL PANEL MEMBERS] are subject to confirmation by
a majority of the members of the legislature in joint session.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-
10.070(c).
