AN ACT

Relating to designation of the Dillingham to Aleknagik road.

---

\* Section 1. PURPOSE. The Wood-Tikchik State Park comprises fully one-half of the Alaska State Park system. The area is unique in its sharp contrasts from the steep mountains rising from the 11 deep parallel lakes, to the forested beaches, islands, and expansive marshes. The park is becoming increasingly popular to local residents and a rapidly growing tourist industry. Both subsistence and recreational users depend upon the access provided by the Dillingham to Aleknagik road. It is therefore the intent of the legislature to designate the Dillingham to Aleknagik road as the Gateway to the Wood-Tikchik State Park.

Sec. 35.40.025. DILLINGHAM TO ALEKNAGIK ROAD. The road from Dillingham to Aleknagik is designated the Gateway to the Wood-Tikchik State Park.
