BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

AN ACT

Making special appropriations for capital projects; and
providing for an effective date.

* Section 1. The appropriations made by secs. 2 and 3 of this Act are for capital projects or are otherwise not one-year appropriations and do not lapse under AS 37.25.010.

* Sec. 2. The sum of \$61,065,000 is appropriated to the scholarship revolving loan fund (AS 14.43.090) to capitalize that fund. The sources for this appropriation are \$61,000,000 from the general fund and \$65,000 from federal receipts.
