AN ACT

Relating to the Board of Nursing Home Administrators; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 08.03.010(c)(9) is amended to read:

(9) Board of Nursing Home Administrators (AS 08.70.010) -- June 30, 1990 [1986].

* Sec. 2. AS 08.70.020(a) is amended to read:

(a) The board consists of three [FIVE] members: one [TWO] nursing home administrator [ADMINISTRATORS] licensed under this chapter and practicing in the state, a registered nurse licensed in the state and having no direct financial interest in any nursing home, and one person [TWO PERSONS] from the general public.

* Sec. 3. AS 08.70.040 is amended to read:

Sec. 08.70.040. BOARD MEETINGS: QUORUM. The board shall meet at least annually [SEMIANNUALLY]. A majority of the board constitutes a quorum.

* Sec. 4. TRANSITION. Notwithstanding the provisions of AS 08.70.-020(a) as amended by sec. 2 of this Act, the members of the Board of Nursing Home Administrators on the effective date of this Act remain on the board until their terms expire or the positions otherwise become vacant.

* Sec. 5. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-10.070(c).
