\* Section 1. AS 14.03.070 is amended to read:

Sec. 14.03.070. SCHOOL AGE. A child who is six years of age or who will become six years of age before August 15 preceding [NOVEMBER 2 FOLLOWING] the beginning of the school year, and who is under the age of 20 and has not completed the 12th grade, is of school age.

\* Sec. 2. AS 14.03.080(d) is amended to read:

(d) A child who is five years of age [OR WHO WILL BECOME FIVE YEARS OF AGE] before August 15 preceding [NOVEMBER 2 FOLLOWING] the beginning of the school year, and who is under school age, may enter a public school kindergarten.

\* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1988.
