BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Sec. 08.86.010. CREATION AND MEMBERSHIP OF BOARD. There is created a Board of Psychologist and Psychological Associate Examiners. It consists of three [FOUR] licensed psychologists, a licensed psychological associate, and one person who has no direct financial interest in the health care industry.

* Sec. 3. Notwithstanding AS 08.86.010, as amended by sec. 2 of this Act, the licensed psychologist-members of the Board of Psychologist and Psychological Associate Examiners who are serving on the board on the effective date of this Act shall continue to serve the remainder of the terms to which they were appointed.

* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
