Relating to the private manufacture of and the definition of an alcoholic beverage; and providing for an effective date.

\* Section 1. AS 04.21 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 04.21.015. PRIVATE MANUFACTURE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES. (a) Except as provided in (b) of this section, the provisions of this title do not apply to the private manufacture of alcoholic beverages.

(b) This section does not apply to AS 04.16.050, 04.16.051, 04.16.080; AS 04.21.010, 04.21.020; alcoholic beverages manufactured in a quantity that exceeds the limit imposed on private manufacture under federal law; or an area that has adopted a local option law under AS 04.11.490 - 04.11.500.

\* Sec. 2. AS 04.21.080(b)(1) is amended to read:

(1) "alcoholic beverage" means spirituous, vinous, malt or other fermented or distilled liquids, whatever the origin, that are intended for human consumption as a beverage and that contain one-half of one percent or more of alcohol by volume, whether produced commercially or privately;
