Establishing a House Special Committee on Tourism.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS tourism is of increasing importance to the economy of the state; and

WHEREAS the legislature should be well informed about developments in tourism in order to plan for the state's future; and

WHEREAS the state should promote tourism and enhance opportunities for visitors to experience Alaskan life and scenic grandeur; and

WHEREAS the future of tourism in the state may be affected by the March 1989 oil spill in Prince William Sound;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives that a House Special Committee on Tourism is established to study issues relating to tourism; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the speaker of the House shall determine the number of representatives to be members of the committee, and shall appoint the members and designate a member to chair the committee; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the House Special Committee on Tourism may meet during and between sessions of the Sixteenth Alaska State Legislature, and is terminated on the convening of the First Session of the Seventeenth Alaska State Legislature.
