Relating to the small business incubator program and to the Matanuska-Susitna Business Development Center Task Force.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS residents and businesses within the Matanuska-Susitna Borough continue to be adversely affected by the current economic recession; and

WHEREAS under the leadership of the Matanuska-Susitna Regional Economic Development Corporation, concerned local professionals and private citizens joined together to share their expertise and established the Matanuska-Susitna Business Development Center Task Force in November 1988; and

WHEREAS a purpose of the task force is to provide assistance and expertise in the development and implementation of a small business incubator program; and

WHEREAS a purpose of the task force is to diversify the local economy and create jobs; and

WHEREAS a small business incubator facility would provide professional, technical and financial assistance to small businesses during their start-up phase; and

WHEREAS the borough's economic development and stability depend primarily on small businesses; and

WHEREAS federal, state, and local funding sources are available for implementation and operation of small business incubator facilities; and

WHEREAS the Alaska State Legislature believes that every effort should be made to improve and stabilize the economy of the Matanuska-Susitna Borough;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature supports the small business incubator concept and the business development efforts of the Matanuska-Susitna Business Development Center Task Force.
