AN ACT

Relating to factors in aggravation of the presumptive  
term of a criminal sentence.

\* Section 1. AS 12.55.155(c) is amended by adding new paragraphs to  
read:

(27) the defendant, being 18 years of age or older,

(A) is legally accountable under AS 11.16.110(2) for  
the conduct of a person who, at the time the offense was com-  
mitted, was under 18 years of age and at least three years  
younger than the defendant; or

(B) is aided or abetted in planning or committing the  
offense by a person who, at the time the offense was committed,  
was under 18 years of age and at least three years younger than  
the defendant;

(28) the victim of the offense is a person who provided  
testimony or evidence related to a prior offense committed by the  
defendant.
