AN ACT

Relating to distribution of information about fetal health effects of alcohol consumption, chemical abuse, and battering during pregnancy.

\* Section 1. AS 18.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 18.05.037. FETAL HEALTH EFFECTS. The department shall prepare or obtain distributable information on fetal alcohol effects and the fetal health effects of chemical abuse and battering during pregnancy. The department shall make this information available to public hospitals, clinics, and other health facilities in the state for distribution to their patients.

\* Sec. 2. AS 25.05.111 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(b) With a license issued under (a) of this section, the licensing officer shall also give to the parties written information about fetal alcohol effects and the fetal health effects of chemical abuse and battering during pregnancy. The Department of Health and Social Services shall prepare or obtain this information and submit it in distributable form to each licensing officer in the state.
