\* Section 1. AS 18.65.085(c) is amended to read:

(c) The Department of Public Safety may establish and administer a reward program, and provide grants to municipalities, [AND] established villages, and, at the request of a municipality or established village, to a nonprofit association that administers a village public safety officer program, for reward programs [,] leading to the apprehension and conviction of persons who violate AS 04.11.010 by selling, importing, or possessing alcoholic beverages in violation of an ordinance adopted by a municipality or established village under AS 04.-11.490 - 04.11.500.
