\* Section 1. AS 18.85.120(c) is repealed and reenacted to read:

(c) Upon the person's conviction, the court may enter a judgment that a person for whom counsel is appointed pay for the necessary services and facilities of representation and court costs, but execution of the judgment may not commence until three years after release of the defendant from incarceration unless for good cause shown, the court considers it appropriate to execute earlier. Upon a showing of financial hardship, the court shall allow a person subject to a judgment entered under this subsection to make payments under a payment schedule. Payments made under this subsection shall be paid into the state general fund.
