\* Section 1. AS 16.05.835 is amended to read:

Sec. 16.05.835. MAXIMUM LENGTH OF SALMON SEINE VESSELS. A salmon seine vessel may not be longer than [50 FEET, OFFICIAL COAST GUARD REGISTER LENGTH, AND] 58 feet overall length except vessels that have fished for salmon with seines in waters of the state before January 1, 1962, as 50-foot, official Coast Guard register length vessels. In this section, "overall length" means the straight line length between the extremities of the vessel excluding anchor rollers.
