AN ACT

Granting probation officers status as peace officers under the public employees' retirement system; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

AN ACT

Granting probation officers status as peace officers under the public employees' retirement system; and providing for an effective date.

* Section 1. AS 39.35.680(28) is amended to read:

(28) "peace officer" or "fire fighter" means an employee occupying a position as a peace officer, chief of police, correctional officer, correctional superintendent, fire fighter, [OR] fire chief, or probation officer;

* Sec. 2. An employee who was employed as a probation officer in the public employees' retirement system before the effective date of this Act, may convert the credited service for that position to credited service as a peace officer by claiming the service as peace officer service before the member is appointed to retirement. When the member claims this retroactive credited service, an indebtedness of the member to the system shall be established. The indebtedness is equal to (1) the contributions to the system that the probation officer would have made if the service had counted as peace officer service, less (2) the contributions to the system that the probation officer actually made. Interest as prescribed by regulation accrues on this indebtedness beginning July 1, 1991. Any outstanding indebtedness that exists at the time a person is appointed to retirement will require an actuarial adjustment to the benefits payable based upon the probation officer service.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
